

Birth Registration Law

Exploring Challenges, Exclusions and Reform

What is the goal of the research?

To gain a deeper understanding of the challenges different people have experienced with the birth registration system, particularly in relation to exclusion. To make suggestions for future law reform.

Who can participate?

Registrars and other professionals who have experience of the birth registration system in England, Wales, or Northern Ireland, to include supporting persons who have experienced challenges, difficulties or exclusion in this context.

What is involved?

Participants are invited to a 60-90 minute interview. These can be on a one-to-one basis with the researcher, or with another colleague or colleagues. Interviews will take place via Microsoft Teams and a list of questions can be provided in advance.
