Summer's well and truly here and we are have been enjoying a lot of weather!

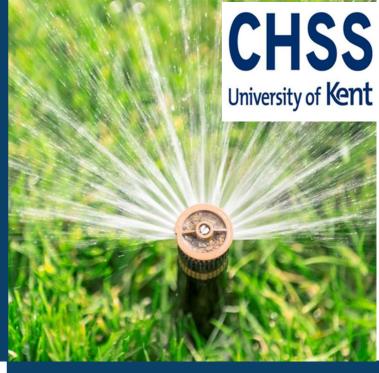
We hope many of you have had or will find time to have a well-deserved break somewhere!
