## Teacher's notes

## Task 6.

A lawyer works at the court.

A teacher works at the school.

A hairdresser works at the salon.

A police officer works at the police station.

A driver works on the bus.

A cleaner works at the office.

A shop assistant works at the shop.

A cook works at the restaurant.

A builder works at the construction site.

A doctor works at the hospital.

## Task 7.

The teacher introduces the question 'What do you do?'.

In pairs, students take turns asking the question. To answer, a student takes one of the cards (see next page), which are laying face down, and answers 'I am a ...'. For example, 'I am a doctor.'

For help, the teacher can write the question and an example answer on the board.

If an easier version of the task is needed, students can shuffle the cards face down, then take turns revealing and naming them.

Alternatively, the cards can be used for listening practice, with the teacher calling out jobs and the students showing the correct card.
