
My name is Senait and I am a store manager at Bradford's. Let me tell you about what happens in our store during a typical day.

My name is Leon and I am a stockroom manager. Let me tell you about what happens there.




Store assistants have to **take inventory** to know what we have and what we need. Last week, we ordered 200 bottles of orange juice and we have already sold 170.
