Task 4.

This is my **mother**. Her name is Anna.

Task 7.

In pairs, students play a game of True or False using the cards from the following page and using the family trees from pages 6 and 7 for reference.

Student A reads out a statement from the *statements* card and student B marks whether it is true or false on their *answers* card.

After both students have read out their statements and marked their answers, they verify their answers.

The student with the most correct answers wins.

Alternatively, this task can be played in pairs with both students reading and answering the statements together using the family trees for reference.

Note.

As it may be a sensitive topic, students are not asked to talk about their own families. However, if the teacher feels it is fitting, a speaking or writing activity may be conducted in which students describe their families.
